THDCIL is Schedule "A" Mini Ratna Government Public Sector Undertaking (PSU). It is one of the premier power generators in the country with installed capacity of 1587 MW with commissioning of Tehri Dam & HPP (1000MW), Koteshwar HEP (400MW), Dhukwan Small HEP (24 MW) and Wind Power Projects of 50MW at Patan ,63MW at Dwarka and 50MW Solar Power Project Kasargod.

The Equity of company is shared between NTPC and GoUP.

The Company was incorporated on 12th July 1988 to develop, operate and maintain the 2400MW Tehri Hydro Power Complex and other Hydro Projects. The Company has an authorized share capital of Rs.4000Cr. THDCIL is a Mini Ratna Category-I and Schedule "A" PSU.

Presently, THDCIL has three operational hydro power plants namely Tehri HPP (1000 MW), Koteshwar HEP (400 MW), Dhukwan Small HEP (24 MW), two operational Wind Power Plants namely Patan Wind Farm (50 MW) and Devbhumi Dwarika Wind Farm (63 MW) and one solar project (50 MW).

Presently, two hydro power projects namely Tehri PSP (1000 MW) & VPHEP (444 MW) and one Thermal Project namely Khurja STPP (1320 MW) are under construction.

THDCIL is consistently profit making company since the commissioning of Tehri Dam & HPP in the year 2006-07.

- 1. Written Test shall be of objective Type of two hours duration consisting of two parts –
- Part-I -Consists of General Aptitude and General Awareness with 40 questions .
- Part-II -Consists of Technical/ Professional knowledge test with 80 questions from respective discipline
- 2. Final Merit of selection of all discipline will be decided based on marks secured by the candidates in Written Test (100% Weightage).
- 3. All questions shall carry equal marks i.e 1 Mark per question. Wrong or multiple answers would result in negative marks of 0.25 or ¼ mark.
- 4. The applicants will have the option to appear for Written Test in HINDI/ENGLISH language. (Question paper will be bilingual).
- 5. The management reserves the right to raise the minimum eligibility standards/criteria/ vacancy and/or conduct a screening test to restrict the number of candidates for Written Test.

6. Empanelment of candidates

Candidates who qualify in the written test will only be adjudged suitable for empanelment.

TEST CENTRES

The Test Centre for Written Test will be **Dehradun & Haldwani** for **Uttarakhand State domicile Candidates and Lucknow, Varanasi, Noida, Jhansi, Kanpur, & Aligarh for Uttar Pradesh domicile candidates.** However, THDCIL reserves the right to increase/ change the test centers at its discretion depending upon the no. of applications. Test centre once allotted will not be changed under any circumstances and no request in this regard shall be entertained. **Candidates have to download their admit Cards through our application portal. Admit card will not be sent by Post.**

HEALTH STANDARDS

Applicants should have sound health. No relaxation in health standard is allowed. Appointment of selected candidates will be subject to their being found medically fit in the Pre- Employment Medical Examination to be conducted as per the Norms and Standards of Medical Fitness prescribed by the corporation

On successful completion of training they will be placed as Jr. Engineer (S-1) at various units/project/ offices of the corporation based on requirement. The Essential Educational Qualification admissible/desired for the mentioned posts shall form the basis for Career progression of the candidate in the organization. Candidates once placed shall have no right to claim promotion /other benefits on the basis of higher education possessed/acquired by them at any point of time.

- 3. Before applying, the candidate should ensure that he/ she fulfill the eligibility criteria and other norms mentioned in this advertisement.
- 4. For the Un-Reserved (UR) vacancy and SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/Ex-SM candidates can apply subject to meeting with all General Standards of Eligibility.
- 5. All eligibility qualification should be regular and recognized from a recognized Institution/ Board/ Council/ University. The minimum percentage of marks in qualifying diploma is 65% taking average of all Semesters/Years/subjects, irrespective of the weightage given to any particular semester/year/subject by the University/Institute. No rounding off of marks obtained shall be allowed.
- 6. Percentage of Marks obtained by the candidate in Diploma shall be calculated based on the practice followed by the University/Board/ Institution from where candidate has obtained the Diploma. Wherever CGPA/OGPA or letter grade is awarded; equivalent percentage of marks should be indicated in the online application form as per norms adopted by the University/ Institute. A certificate for conversion of Grades/CGPA to percentage of marks shall be based on the procedure certified by the University/Institution from where they have obtained Diploma and shall be sent while sending the downloaded application through post.. In case the University/Institution does not have any scheme for converting CGPA into equivalent marks the equivalence would be established by dividing the candidates CGPA by maximum possible CGPA and multiplying the result with 100.

- 8. Candidates with Two Years Diploma/ Sandwich Diploma Course/ Qualification acquired through Distance Learning Mode or Part Time Mode shall not be considered
