## 4. General Information and Instructions

- 4.1. a. Candidates must be Indian Nationals only with excellent academic record and excellent commitment to quality in teaching and research.
  - b. Candidates should possess the required educational qualifications in relevant branch / specialization experience and other requirements (as applicable) specified as on 29.09.2020.
  - c. In addition to U.G. and P.G. Degrees, Ph.D. Degree shall also be a mandatory educational qualification for the appointment of Assistant Professors and Assistant University Librarian Grade I in Anna University.
  - d. Educational qualifications, experiences etc. mentioned in this Notification indicate the minimum eligibility.
- 4.2. The last date for updating the application through online mode is 20.10.2021 (17.30 Hrs. IST).
- 4.3 a. After successful submission of the updated online application(s), the candidate shall download the same, affix signatures at appropriate places and send them along with all the relevant enclosures to the Registrar, Anna University, Chennai 600 025 only by Speed / Registered Post with acknowledgement due so as to reach him on or before 27.10.2021 (17.30 Hrs. IST). The envelope containing the application and enclosures should be superscribed on the left hand top corner as "Application for the post of \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the Department(s) / Centre of \_\_\_\_\_ and code No(s). \_\_\_\_\_ b. The self-attested photocopies of the documents (as given in Annexure V) have to be sent along with the hard copy of each application.
- 4.4 The candidates are requested to send the scanned copy of the Speed Post / Registered Post receipt to annauniversityrecruitmentcell@gmail.com immediately after sending the hard copy.
- 4.5 The hard copy of the updated online application(s) along with supporting documents received on or before the due date at the office of the Registrar, Anna University Chennai 25 shall be considered for further processing. Hand written application shall not be accepted. The applications received after the last date will be summarily rejected.

### 4.6 Experience

- a. Teaching experience is not mandatory for Assistant Professor in Engineering & Technology, Management, Architecture, Town Planning and Assistant University Librarian Grade-I in University Library. However, for Assistant Professor in Science & Humanities, post Ph.D. experience that includes Research Experience and / or Teaching Experience is mandatory.
- b. The Service rendered in regular Scale of Pay / Pay Band / Pay Matrix as per AICTE Regulations alone shall be considered as teaching experience.
- c. For post Ph.D. teaching experience, candidates are requested to enclose the following documents Institution-wise in chronological order without fail, while forwarding hard copy of application:
  - i. Advertisement for Recruitment of post concerned indicating the qualifications and other requirements as per the norms of regulatory bodies,
  - ii. Interview / Call Letter,
  - iii. Appointment Letter,
  - iv. Joining Report,
  - v. Salary Certificates issued by the Institution indicating the Scale of Pay / Pay Band / Pay Matrix for the Posts held
  - vi. Last Pay Drawn Certificates,
  - vii. Income Tax Returns for the period of service claimed
  - viii. Service Certificate at the time of relieving.

The post Ph.D. teaching service shall be counted only based on the valid documents submitted by the candidates while screening the application and any request for relaxation to submit the above documents at a later date shall not be strictly entertained. Further, if any one of the above documents is not submitted along with hard copy of application, such application will be summarily rejected without any communication.

- 4.7. Applications from candidates who are already employed shall be considered only if the applications are forwarded through proper channel (Head of the Institution / Organization) with a "No Objection Certificate" (as per FORMAT-III) from the present employer failing which the application is liable to be summarily rejected. Advance copy of the application will not be accepted.
- 4.8. Applications without satisfying educational qualifications in relevant branch / specialization & experience (as applicable) / Incomplete Applications / Applications without proper enclosures / Applications filled with discrepancy / Applications which are not forwarded through proper channel will be summarily rejected and no information will be sent to the candidate to this effect.
- 4.9. Reservation policy shall be as per Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016
- 4.10. Appointment on deputation basis will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 4.11. All the Original documents shall be produced at the time of Interview for verification.
- 4.12. Canvassing in any form shall be a disqualification.

- 4.13. The online applications / hard copy of applications of the candidates who are not selected will be retained only for six months from the date of completion of the recruitment process.
- 4.14. In case of any disputes, any suit or legal proceedings shall be filed within six months from the date of issue of appointment order to any cadre and the territorial Jurisdiction shall be Madras High Court, Chennai.
- 4.15. Candidates should necessarily fill in the information regarding pending court cases, criminal cases, disciplinary actions or equivalent etc. against him / her in the relevant column of the application form. Any changes in this information as and when takes place after the submission of application form till the completion of recruitment process shall be brought to the notice of the University by the candidate, failing which the University reserves the right to cancel the candidature and to debar the candidate from all selections at any point of time.
- 4.16. Candidates possessing Ph.D. Degree in relevant specialization with all other requirements specified in this notification and having equivalent U.G. / P.G. Degree as approved by the Higher Education Department, Government of Tamil Nadu are also eligible to apply.
- 4.17. The pay and other allowances shall be as per 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission for the candidates.
- 4.18. The selected candidates shall be governed by Contributory Pension Scheme as per the prevailing rules of Government of Tamil Nadu.
- 4.19. Age shall not be less than 24 years on 1st July 2020.
- 4.20. The selection process consists of

  - Presentation before the Subject Experts and
  - Personal Interview with the Members of the Selection Committee
- 4.21. No correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from candidates regarding reason for not being called for Written Test / Interview / outcome of Interview.
- 4.22.a. The date and time of Written Test, Presentation and Interview will be hosted in the Anna University website. In addition, communication will be sent to the registered e-Mail id.
  - b. Requests for change of date of Written Test, Presentation and Interview will not be entertained.
  - c. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the Written Test, Presentation and Interview.
  - d. The Selection process may not be completed on the same day.

- & Humanities and University Library.
- Application of the candidates who have completed U.G. / P.G. / Ph.D. in Engineering and Technology and Architecture under Distance Mode shall not be considered.
- Application of the candidates who have completed M.Phil. and Ph.D. under Correspondence / Distance Education / Open University System from the academic year 2007-2008 shall not be considered as per G.O.(Ms) No.91, Higher Education (K2) Department, dated 03.04.2009.
- Experience shall be considered only from the date of successful completion of Ph.D. (from the date of Ph.D. viva-voce examination) in the relevant area of specialization for all positions in Science and Humanities.

- If a qualified and suitable woman candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Castes (Arunthathiyar), Backward Class Muslims, Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes (Vanniakula Kshatriya), Most Backward Class and Denotified Communities, Most Backward Classes and General Turn is not available for selection for appointment in the turn allotted for women in the cycle, then, the turn so allotted shall be filled by a male candidate in the same category in roster.
- Provided that if even after filling up of the required appointments or posts reserved for Arunthathiyars amongst the Scheduled Castes, if more number of qualified Arunthathiyars are available, such excess number of candidates of Arunthathiyars shall be entitled to compete with the other Scheduled Castes in the inter-se-merit among them and if any appointment or post reserved for Arunthathiyars remain unfilled for want of adequate number of qualified candidates, it shall be filled up by Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars.
